

Year 11 Fine Art GCSE - AQA

Art is a two year linear course with coursework and final pieces leading to an external 10 hour exam.

Topics:

Identity Project continued: (Sept-Dec 19) You will explore your own personal & precious objects and study your own image in unusual ways.

Exam Component: (Jan-April 20) After selecting 1 topic out of 8 choices, you will produce a shorter project. This will result in a 10 hour final piece in exam conditions.

Skills:

Through workshops and visiting artists you will continue to advance your skills in a variety of skills and techniques: Lino printing/pen work/ watercolour/acrylic/ photography/mono printing/surface embellishment/etc.

Research:

Artist research is particularly important. You will learn to analyse and evaluate a selection of chosen artists to help inspire your work. Use our Shared Area on the school computer and teacher's Pinterest, as well as other websites.

Assessment:

Your teacher will continually assess your coursework and give regular feedback to help you progress. Your mock exam will be your Identity Final Piece (10 hours) Your GCSE exam will result in a Final Piece of 10 hours. All Year 10 & 11 projects and finals plus your exam will be marked to form you GCSE grade.

Complete homework on time and to your highest standard
Work independently and take responsibility of your learning
