Topics

In Year 10, you will study the following topics:

Autumn Term: healthy living, food, sport, free time activities

Spring Term: home, town, neighbourhood, region, the environment

Summer Term: my studies, life at school, jobs, charity/volunteer work

You will continue to practise the four skills of listening, speaking, reading (including translation from Italian into English) and writing (including translation into Italian).

Grammar

Grammar will be taught and revisited throughout the course in each unit of work. This will include:

- a range of tenses (present, perfect, imperfect, future, conditional)
- impersonal phrases
- comparatives and superlatives
- question words



Assessment

At the end of each unit you will complete a topic card in preparation for the speaking and writing exams and there will be end-of-unit assessments.

In the summer exam you will take papers in all four skills.
