You will continue to practise the four skills of listening, speaking, reading (including translation from Spanish) and writing (including translation into Spanish).

Grammar

Grammar will be taught and revisited throughout the course in each unit of work. This will include:

- a range of tenses (present, preterite, perfect, imperfect, future, conditional)
- adjectives
- comparatives and superlatives
- question words
- prepositions
- recognition of the subjunctive

Assessment

At the end of each unit you will complete a topic card in preparation for the speaking and writing exams and there will be end-of-unit assessments.

In the December mocks you will take papers in all four skills. As the GCSE is linear assessment is by final examination in the summer term. Oral exams will be before study leave.
