

French A level: Year 13



Topics

In Year 13, you will study the following topics:

- The positive impacts of immigration in France
- The challenges of immigration and integration in France
- The Far Right in France
- Occupied France during WW2
- The Vichy Regime
- The Resistance in France during WW2
- **French novel: Le Gone du Chaâba written by Azouz Begag.**
- Revise year 12 topics and the film.



You will continue to practise the four skills as well as translation into and out of French. You will also develop your **research skills for the Speaking Independent Research Project**. You will also have weekly speaking classes with our French conversation assistant Mme Hunt in small groups and this will be timetabled during a study period.

Grammar

Grammar will be taught and revisited throughout the course in each unit of work. This will include all grammar from GCSE, year 12 and more complex structures:

- Present, perfect, imperfect, pluperfect, conditional, future tenses
- Present subjunctive
- Passive voice and imperative
- Nouns, gender, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs
- Etc...



Assessment

You will be regularly tested throughout the course and there will be a Mock Exam in all three papers around the end of the first term.

In the summer, you will take three exam papers that will include assessments in Listening, Reading, Translation and Essay Writing on the film and the novel.
