## Topics

In Year 13, you will study the following topics:

- The positive impact of immigration
- Problems surrounding migration in Italy
- The North/South divide
- Mussolini's rise to power
- Fascism during World War Two
- From dictatorship to democracy: the fall of Mussolini, the liberation and the 6 Nations
- **Italian novel: *Io non ho paura* by Niccolò Ammaniti**



You will continue to practise the four skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing, as well as translation into and out of Italian. **You will also have weekly speaking classes with our conversation assistant, Enza.** This will be timetabled during a study period.

## Grammar

Grammar will be taught and revisited throughout the course in each unit of work. This will include all grammar from GCSE, year 12 and more complex structures:

- Present, perfect, imperfect, pluperfect, conditional, future tenses
- Present subjunctive and imperfect subjunctive
- Passive voice and imperative
- Nouns, gender, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs

## Assessment

You will be regularly tested throughout the course and there will be a Mock Exam in all three papers around the end of the first term.

In the summer, you will take three exam papers that will include assessments in Listening, Reading, Translation and Essay Writing on the film and the novel.
