- **Spanish Literary Text: *Bodas de Sangre* (by Federico García Lorca)**



You will continue to practise listening, speaking, reading and writing, as well as translation into and out of Spanish.

You will continue your weekly speaking classes with our Spanish conversation assistant Susanna. This will be in a free/ study period.

Grammar

Grammar will be taught and revisited throughout the course in each unit of work. This will include:

- Present, preterite, imperfect, conditional, future tenses
- Present subjunctive
- Imperfect subjunctive
- Compound tenses
- Gerund and present progressive
- Passive voice / impersonal 'se'

Assessment

You will be regularly tested on both vocabulary and grammar throughout the course and there will be end-of-unit assessments.

In the December mocks and A Level you will take papers that will include assessment in all four
