

Biology A Level Bridging Work

The best thing that you can do to prepare for studying Biology at A level is to buy the CGP book '[Head Start to A-Level Biology](#)'. It is £4.95, but you can download it free as a Kindle book on Amazon. The book reinforces key concepts that you studied at GCSE and that we will develop further at A level, meaning that you will be superconfident when you start the course in September!

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I suggest that you buy the book this week and, starting from Monday 27th April to the summer half term, cover the following sections:

4 weeks from 27th April - Half Term

Week Beginning 27th April	Sections 1 and 2
Week Beginning 4th May	Sections 3 and 4
Week Beginning 11th May	Sections 5 and 6
Week Beginning 18th May	Sections 7 and 8

Rather than making notes, aim to **process the information** in each section into a concept map, a poster or revision cards, although the best way of really understanding a topic is to teach it to a friend, parent, sibling, etc. I know making revision cards now can seem too early, but you'll thank yourself when doing tests and exams!
