First Women's Campaigns



Mrs. F. ... was born in 1848 to a middle-class family. She was the sister of Elizabeth Garrett Anderson. When she was 23 years old she heard a speech by John Stuart Mill, which made a big impression on her. She became actively involved in his campaign. Her sister's struggle to qualify and practice as a doctor also encouraged Millicent to support the women's suffrage movement.
