Dates of the festival


The dates are always on the last Wednesday in August.

It's purely for entertainment purposes, no one is completely certain how it even originated.


One popular theory is that disgruntled townspeople attacked city councilmen with tomatoes during a town celebration.

History of the festival

It's been going on from 1944 or 1945. It's a free festival and people 18+ can show up and get involved. La tomatina was banned in the early 50s, but this did not stop the participants who were arrested. It was again banned in 1957, it was banned because according to Francisco Franco it had no religious signification.



What happens at the festival

People throw tomatoes at each other and get involved in a tomato fight purely for entertainment purposes.
