

Holiday Destination: Nice (south of france)

Day 1



Nice is located in the South of France, close to Italy.



First we fly from London, Stansted airport to Nice airport at 10 am and it takes about 2 hours and 10 minutes on the plane. From the airport a taxi takes 15 minutes to get to the Hotel Le Grimaldi. We check in at the hotel at around pm, so we leave our bags and go out to eat.

We go to Le Sejour Cafe that's really close to the hotel.



We eat ratatouille, it actually originated in Nice, and crêpes for a dessert.



After a couple of hours, we leave the cafe and walk back to the hotel. It's now the evening so we go to sleep.

Day 2

We wake up in the morning around 9 and go down for breakfast. We have a simple breakfast and decide to go sightseeing. First, we take a 16 minute walk from the hotel to the Musée d'art moderne et d'art contemporain.



We look at the different displays like some pop art. After a few hours in the museum, we leave and take a 30 minute walk to the next destination, Musée Matisse.



The Musée Matisse in Nice is a municipal museum devoted to the work of French painter Henri Matisse. It gathers one of the world's largest collections of his works, tracing his artistic beginnings and his evolution through his last works.

We get back to the hotel and have an early dinner. It's now around 17:30pm so for the rest of the day we stay in our room and relax.

Day 3

Today, we wake up early and pack our swimming costumes and towels to go to Promenade des Anglais for the day. After we are ready, we take a taxi to the beach.

The promenade has a large walkable way with a dedicated bike street. The Promenade buildings are historical ones and very very beautiful. The Beach is very spacious. It stretches for miles and is a great place for exercise and people watching, and admiring the sites of Nice.



We rent bicycles and have an hour of fun. After our bike ride, we walk on the sand of the beach.
