A vegetable stew made up of tomatoes, courgettes, peppers, aubergines, onions, and herbs and served with bread, pasta, or rice.

Bouillabaisse

A fish stew of boney rockfish cooked in a broth made of spices, herbs, onions, and tomatoes and served with bread.



Pissaladiere

A dough is topped with herbs, onions, garlic, sugar, salt, tomatoes, olives, and anchovies.

- Le Suquet - the old town with views over the red roofs of Cannes
