This dress was made my Charles James in 1955 he wanted to design a dress inspired by metamorphosis so he came it with this.




It is made from silk, synthetic and metal. He designed the front of the dress to represent the cocoon of the butterfly. The back of the dress is to represent the butterfly wings it has 20 layers of synthetic material it weighs a total of 8 pounds! When he first sold this dress he sold it for \$1,250 but now it goes for around \$12,000. The owner of it today says it's quite comfortable to wear.
