# Sixth Form Uniform:

## Make a good start & get it right!



- Sixth Formers are always required to dress smartly and formally in a suit and be presentable. You will also be expected to wear a lanyard.

For girls we expect:

- A tailored skirt of mid-length (not of stretch fabric) with a suit jacket  
**or**  
Tailored trousers, with a suit jacket  
**or**  
A smart dress (non-stretch) of mid length with a suit jacket  
These may be worn with smart shoes or smart ankle boots

For boys we expect:

- A two or three piece suit  
Collared shirt  
Smart shoes or smart boots

For both girls and boys we expect:

- **No facial or visible body piercings, other than earrings**
- No extreme hair colours or hair styles
- No jeans or leggings
- **No trainers or canvas shoes**
- Shoulders and midriffs are not to be exposed
