It was wonderful this morning to welcome all of our students back into school. It has been a long time coming and we are pleased to have them back with us. New offices have been created from store cupboards to allow for staff social distancing and a 20-week project to replace the flat roofs on the science block, admin area, hall and gym has commenced. All classrooms in the school have new pedal bins, sanitiser, cleaning materials and all tables are facing forward. I would like to thank all of those involved with this work, ensuring that everything was completed on time.
