We look forward to welcoming the majority of the Year 8 bubble back to school on Monday. There is still a small number who continue to be in self-isolation and we look forward to when they can return.

Due to three positive cases in Year 11 on Tuesday and Wednesday, we asked the year group to work from home. I thought we were busy until I had communication this week with another Headteacher in Hertfordshire who has had 36 positive cases in 10 school days.
