COVID

We are waiting on the test results for a number of students across all year groups. I don't believe it is going to be possible to telephone every parent over the weekend if we need to ask students to self-isolate. From now on, we will action the following:

- If we receive notice of a positive result during the school day, then parents will be contacted by telephone advising them of next steps.
- If we receive notice of a positive result during in the evening or over the weekend, then parents will be contacted by email.



• If we receive notice of a positive result in the evening or over the weekend and we cannot be clear who the close contacts are, then we will have to close the bubble for the following day to allow tracing work to take place. Parents will be informed by email of this decision.
