Soup – from the French word soupe

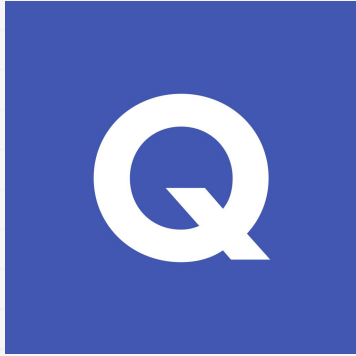
Zest – from the French word zeste

Uniform – from the Middle French word uniforme

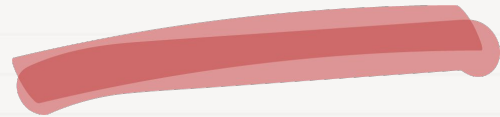

French is the official language in 29 countries. These countries are listed below.

Belgium, Benin, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cameroon, Canada, Chad, the Ivory Coast, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, France, Haiti, Luxembourg, Madagascar, Mali, Monaco, Niger, Rwanda, Senegal, Seychelles, Switzerland, Togo and Vanuatu.



It is estimated that 275 million people across the globe speak French and it is thought that it is the 5th most spoken language behind English, Mandarin Chinese, Hindi and Spanish.
