



This is an extract from an Asterix and Obelix cartoon.


I decided to watch this because my Grandma once showed it to me when I was younger at one of her houses in France, and I remember enjoying it

French speaking countries








French speaking countries

French is a language that is spoken all over the world, although it is mainly since 1945 that the language has grown so much. There are now 33 countries in which French is either the official language, or one of the official languages. These countries are normally found in Africa, North America and Europe.

A few of the French speaking countries include Benin, Belgium, Canada, the Ivory Coast, Madagascar, Senegal and Mali. There are a few flags of some French speaking countries on the next slide.





Capitals of French speaking countries

Antananarivo

Antananarivo is the capital and largest city of Madagascar, an island off South Africa. It was founded in the 17th century, and was the capital of the Hova chiefs.

The city sits at 1280m above sea level in the centre of the island, and is the highest national capital among the island countries.





Port-au-Prince

Port-au-Prince is the capital of Haiti. It has a population density of around 40,000 residents per square mile, and houses 25% of all Haitians. It has a tropical climate with an average annual temperature of 28 degrees C.

Bern

Bern or Berne is the capital of Switzerland, and is situated slightly west of the centre and 20 km north of the Alps. Bern's official title is actually Bundesstadt, and the city was founded in 1191 by a Duke.

The city covers a total area of 52 square kilometres.





Bamako

Bamako is the capital of Mali, and is situated on the floodbanks of the river Niger.

When it was occupied by the French in 1880 under Captain Joseph Simon Gallieni, Bamako was a settlement of a few hundred inhabitants. It then became the capital of the former colony of French Sudan in 1908, and has since progressed to be the capital of Mali.

Famous geographical features in French speaking countries

Mountain ranges

The Alps are the highest and longest mountain range that lies entirely in Europe. It stretches across 1200 km eight european countries: France, Switzerland, Monaco, Italy, Liechtenstein, Austria, Germany and Slovenia.

The alpine region has over 14 million inhabitants, Grenoble being the largest city in the Alps, with 500,000 residents.





Coastlines

Canada has the longest coastline in the world, measuring approximately 151,019 miles long! The distance is so long that if you walked just over 12 miles a day, it would take you over 30 years to walk the whole coast.

French is one of Canada's official languages, along with English.



Forests

French Guiana houses over 7,500,000 hectares of tropical rainforest. This includes part of the Amazon Rainforest itself, as French Guiana lies between Brazil and Suriname in the North of South America.

French is the official language in French Guiana.
