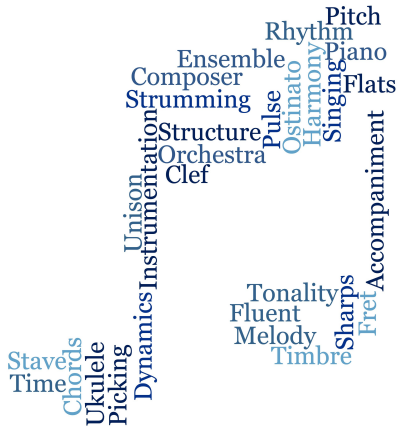


Year 7 KS3 Music Curriculum Overview



Year 7 Music Learning Outcomes

In Year 7 Music students start with introductory skills as students arrive from KS2 with varying levels of musical experience. Students will participate in group and pair work under the three main strands of music; performing, composing and listening.

Topics you will cover in Year 7:

Repetitive Elements

An introductory project to music; getting to know your musical self and establishing musical elements through improvising, composing, singing and playing ostinati

Keyboard and Logic Pro

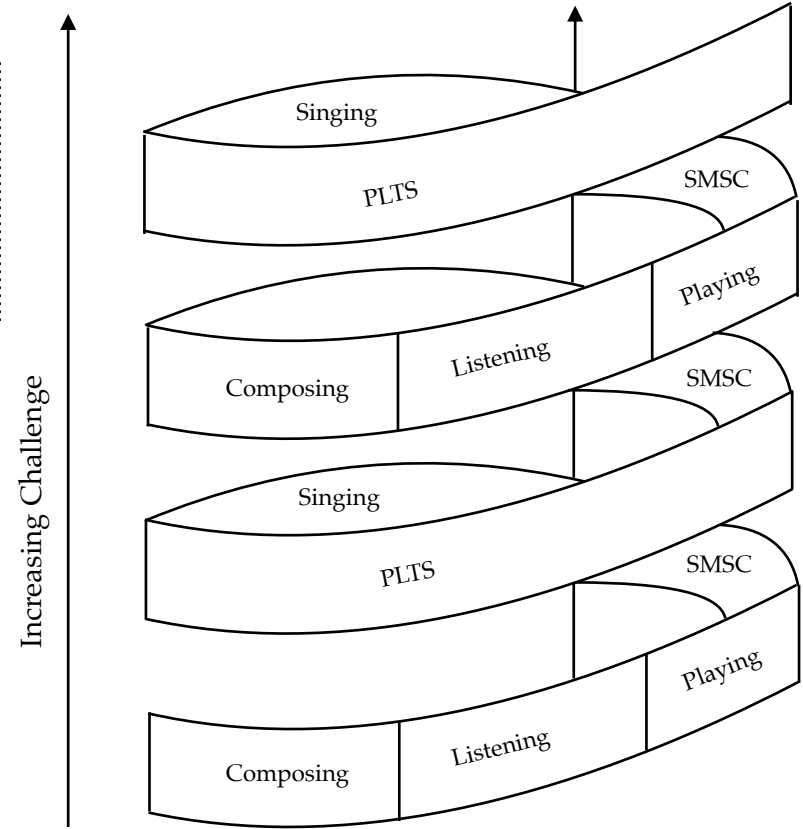
Learning staff notation through performing on the keyboard and recording with music software, both as part of a pair and a soloist

Ukulele and Singing

An exploration of choral and small group singing and ukulele skills through performing popular song

Instruments of the Orchestra

Exploring instruments of the orchestra through programmatic pieces. Composing to a learner defined brief using musical elements
