Pantalone typically wore tight red pants with a matching shirt, a long black cape, black or red pointed shoes, and a belt that had a purse attached. Pantalone also carried a knife and handkerchief, he also wore glasses and a hat.

While the theories of the St Pantaleone and the lion of St Mark are common, they are both now considered unlikely origins, and the true origin is unknown. The name Pantaloon generally means "old fool" or "dotard". The role of Pantalone is usually spoken entirely in the Venetian dialect.

Is pantalone a low or high status character?

Pantalone holds the highest social status in the commedia hierarchy as he is rich and miserly. He always has servants working for him and is deathly afraid of losing his money which would cause him to lose his place in society.
