Student testing information

To speed up the testing process, we will be sending out registration cards and barcodes in the post this week. We would ask that students are pre-registered before arriving at school. You will receive one envelope per family and it will contain the following for each student that has given consent:

2 x registration cards

One set of 3 barcodes (the bar codes on the sheet have the same number)

Actions:

- Write student name and form on both registration cards
- Stick a barcode on each registration card
- Leave the last barcode on the sheet
- Bring both registration cards and the last barcode to the test session

Registering your test

TESTS CAN ONLY BE REGISTERED NO MORE THAN 24 HOURS BEFORE THE TEST IS DUE TO TAKE PLACE

Option 1:

Go to <https://test-for-coronavirus.service.gov.uk/register-kit>

Or

Option 2:

Scan the QR code on the registration card (the web address on the registration card is not correct)

Follow the instructions and register the test. I would suggest that an account is set up, as this will speed up the process for subsequent tests. **A reminder that tests should not be registered more than 24 hours before the test is due to take place.**

Arriving for the test

If the test has successfully been registered then please go directly to the sports hall at the allocated time. Students will be directed to enter the sports hall from the rear of the building, please use the pathway on the left hand side as you face the building.

If you were unable to register the test, then please go to the gym, entering via the back door and a member of staff will be there to register the test. Please be advised that this may increase the length of time students are in school for their test.

Parking will be limited on the school site. Please do not park by the sports hall.

Face coverings must be worn at all times

Taking the test

In order to speed up the process, please ensure that students are fully aware of how to self-administer the test (Test supervisors will also take students through this process before they are tested). Miss Clarke has kindly been videoed taking a test. You can watch the video [here](#).

We have already received requests for specific testing times. You will see from the testing timetable that offering bespoke times will be a challenge. I would only expect to offer a different time slot in extreme circumstances, e.g. hospital appointments
