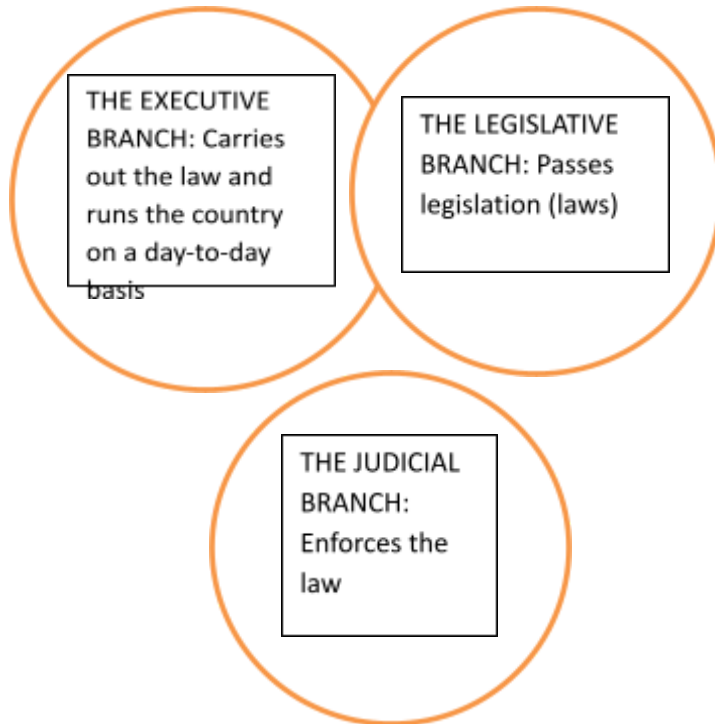


THE BRANCHES OF GOVERNMENT
