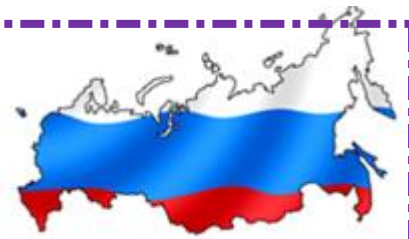


YEAR 13 RUSSIAN



Topics

In Year 13, you will study the following topics:

You will continue to practise the four skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing, as well as translation into and out of Russian.

You will also continue to have weekly speaking classes with our conversation assistant in a free/ study period.

Grammar

Grammar will be taught and revisited throughout the course in each unit of work. This will include all grammar from GCSE and some new grammar:

- Developed case usage
- Verbal aspect
- Passive voice in all three forms
- Participles

Assessment

You will be regularly tested on both vocabulary and grammar throughout the course and there will be end-of-unit assessments.

In the summer exam you will take papers that will include assessment in all four skills.
