You need to choose one of the above design movements (one that you are not familiar with) and produce an A3 information page and an A3 moodboard. The information needs to include the following:

Information Page:

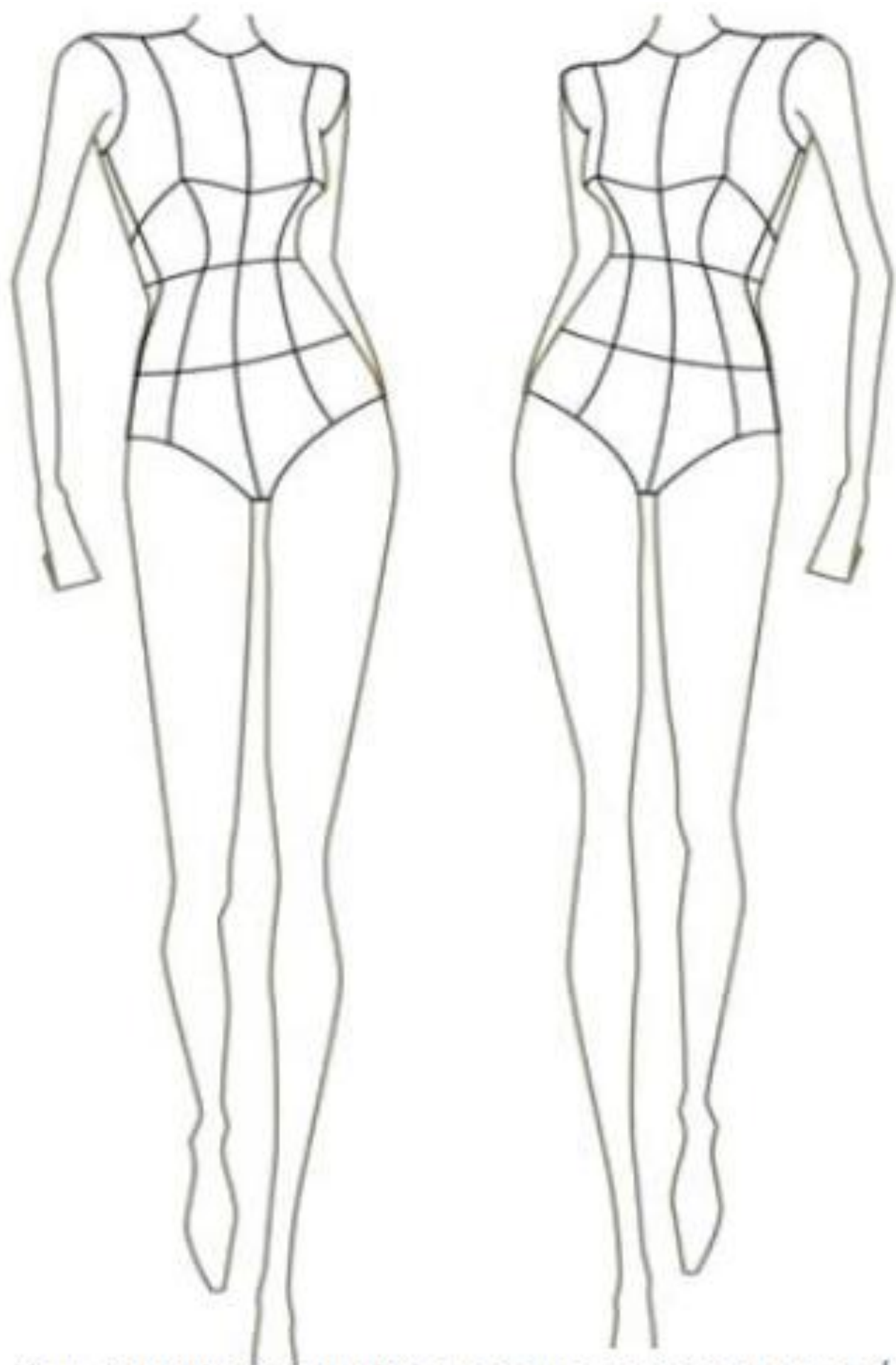
- Who or what started the movement (as well as key designers and artists linked)
- Design inspirations (where ideas came from; e.g. gender, pop culture, art)
- The key fashion products or trends that influenced fashion (key 'iconic' clothing items)
- Any other information that you can find that you think is relevant

Moodboard:

- Historical designs inspired by the design movement (these do not have to be fashion based)
- Contemporary designs inspired by the design movement (these do not have to be fashion based)
- Your own patterns and designs inspired by the design movement

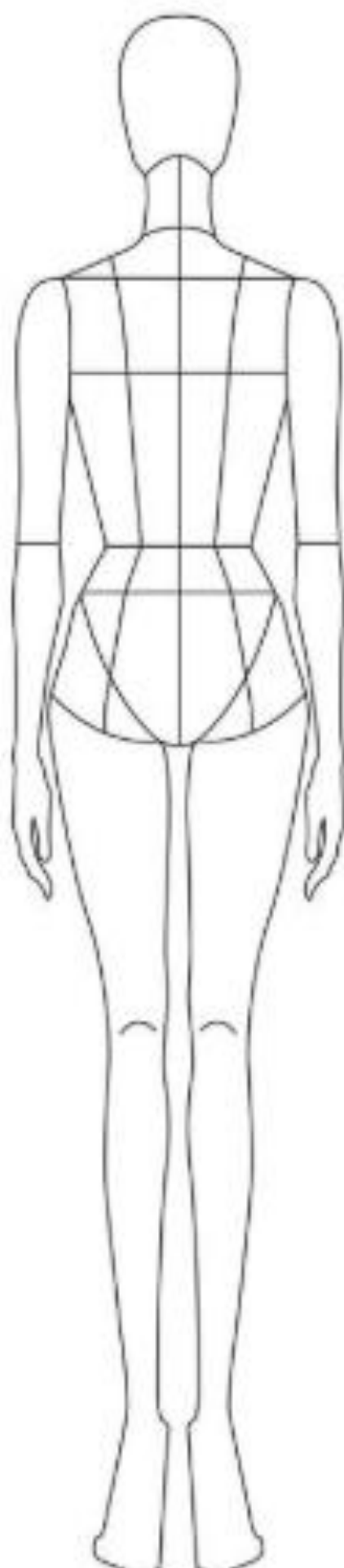

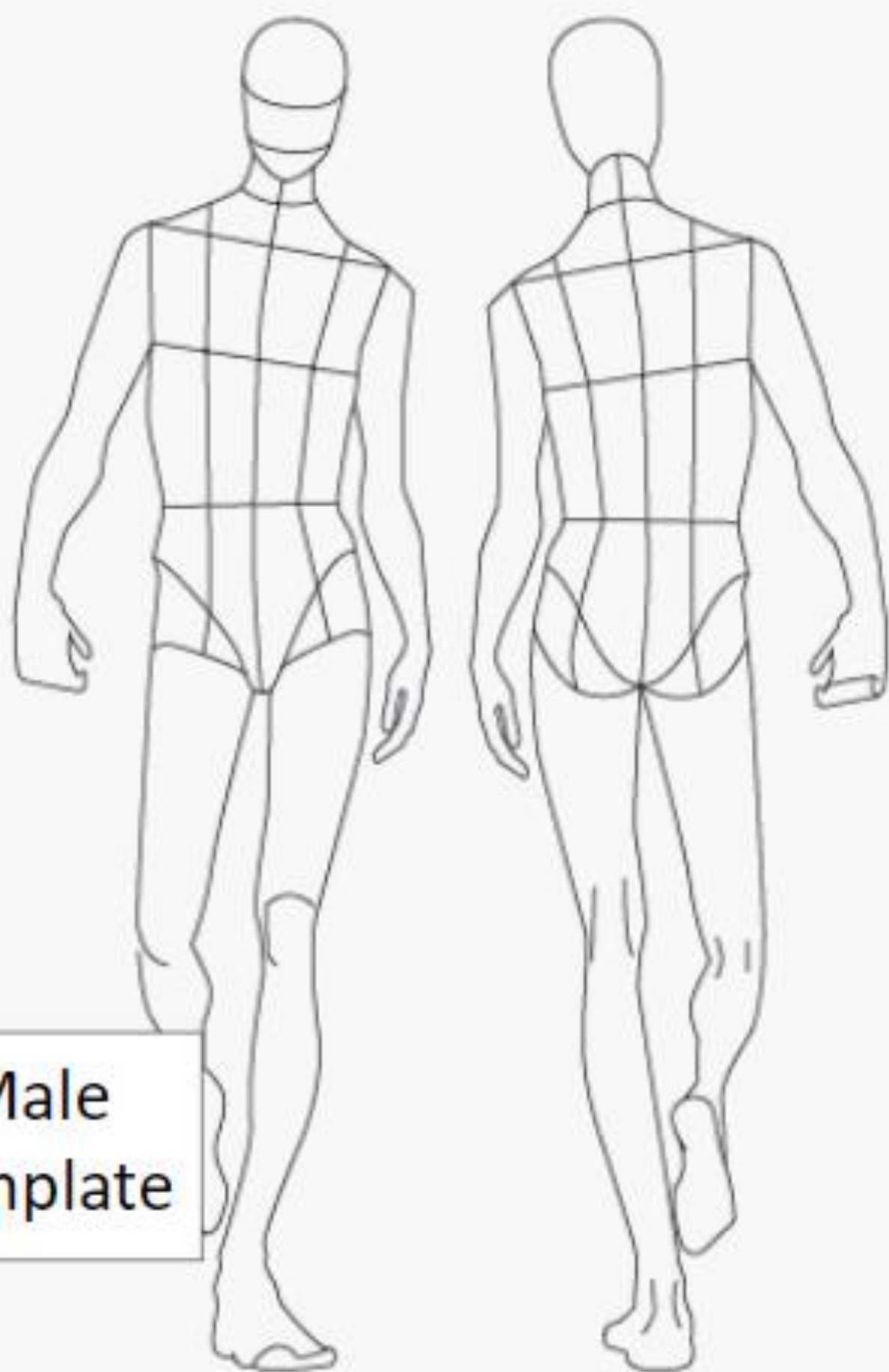
- Your designing skills and style (I want to see your individual style)
