## Year 12 Bridging work-Drama and Theatre Studies.

1. You should do an A4/A3 page of research on <u>3 or more</u> of the 6 named influential Theatre Practitioners. (So you will have at least 3 pages of A4/A3 to submit)

You can choose how to present your research. You may want to include images/sketches etc.

## Your research should address the following areas for each practitioner:

- 1. Key dates (e.g when he/she was born, when they were influencing theatre etc.)
- 2. Practitioner Theories and Practice (e.g what ideas did they have about Theatre, what styles are they known for, how were their ideas into practice?)
- 3. Plays and Performances (e.g. Did they write/direct/produce any plays in their lifetime? What?)
- 4. Political Beliefs (e.g. did their politics/personal morals influence their theatre? If so, how?)
- 5. Overall Influence (e.g. what impact has this practitioner had on Theatre? Are there any contemporary theatre companies/directors who take inspiration from the work of this practitioner?)
