Dear Parent/Carer/Student

Last year, Ofsted removed the directive which meant that schools who had achieved an Outstanding grade in their last inspection would not be re-inspected. Within Hertfordshire, there are only two secondary schools who have been inspected further back than Presdales; our last full inspection was in 2008. All year, we have been waiting for the call from Ofsted, and we still wait. Since September 2021, only 20% of previously outstanding schools that have been inspected have kept their outstanding grade. The new framework that was released in September 2019 is much more rigorous than previous frameworks and the agenda is to reduce the number of outstanding schools in the country. We are determined to demonstrate that Presdales is an outstanding school and will do so in the context of the above. We continue to seek ways to improve what we do, and will always do so.

I think we can all reflect back on another successful year. We anticipate fantastic outcomes for our Year 11 and 13 students, trips are back up and running, school events are taking place again and hundreds of students are taking part in extracurricular activities every week.

As we reach the summer break, I want to say thank you to our staff, students, and parents for the collective role everyone has played this year in providing, what I believe, to be an outstanding educational experience for our students. Everyone has played their part, and all parts are of equal importance.
