Pastoral Reminders for Students

- It is getting colder, in and outside of school, but coats are not allowed to be worn in lessons. Students are allowed to wear a short or long-sleeved T Shirt under their school shirt (it also needs to be white)
- Students should not be using their mobile phones in lessons (unless given permission to do so by their teacher), in the corridor between lessons, queuing up for break or lunch, or just generally walking around school. Mobile phone usage is only at break and lunchtime and only outside of the school building. Sixth Form students are allowed to use their phones in Sixth Form areas (not the dining room)
- Students should not be wearing false nails or false eyelashes
- Whilst the hall is out of action for exams, students are allowed in their zone rooms at break time. This will revert back to the hall as soon as the exams are finished. However, if zone rooms are left in a mess at the end of break or lunch, you will lose the privilege of being allowed to use them.
- Students that have a packed lunch are allowed to eat in the dining room when it is their year group's rotation, or if the lunch supervisors can see there is space in the dining room
- If you are purchasing breakfast in the dining room before school, this needs to be consumed in the dining room and not anywhere else in the school building
