A Level Business Bridging Work



"The Death of the British High Street"

The British high street has been experiencing a very difficult and challenging time of the last 5 or so years, with a number of big brands disappearing from the high street altogether.

Your task is to conduct an analysis of the factors that have contributed to these difficulties.

You should use a PESTLE Analysis to structure your analysis

Structure of Task

Introduction

• Briefly explain what PESTLE analysis is

<u>Main Body</u>

- Pick 3 PESTLE factors (no more than 3)
- For each of the 3, you should analyse how the high street retailers have been impacted by the factor
- Analysis requires you to build a logical chain of reasoning. This means you should how/why the high street retailers have been impacted. You should use language such as 'because', 'leading to', 'therefore' etc.
- Context: You should aim to use real business examples in your analysis in order to demonstrate your point (can be different businesses).

<u>Conclusion</u>

- You should make an overall judgement as to whether or not the "high street is dead"
- If so, why?
- Is there any evidence you have found that may suggest it is not dying?

Additional Information

- Your analysis should be a minimum of 500 words
- You should bring your electronic/hand written (electronic preferred) to the first lesson in September ready to submit
