You will have seen in the news recently the ever-increasing number of young people who are using vapes on a regular basis. We are also experiencing an increase in the number of incidents involving vapes. In our Parent Information evenings in September, we will be addressing the dangers of vaping. We also intend to raise awareness, educate and inform students of these dangers through our SMSC and PSHE sessions in school. Alongside trying to educate students about the potential dangers of vaping, we have updated our behaviour policy as a result of the increased number of issues we are experiencing. This has been agreed with our trust board and is in line with many other Hertfordshire secondary schools and will start in September.
