Grammar

Grammar will be taught and revisited throughout the course in each unit of work. This will include all grammar from GCSE and some new grammar:

Present, perfect, imperfect, pluperfect, conditional, future tenses

Present subjunctive

Passive voice

Nouns, gender, pronouns and the case system

Word order in complex sentences

Assessment

You will be regularly tested on both vocabulary and grammar throughout the course and there will be end-of-unit assessments.

In the summer exam you will take papers that will include assessment in all four skills.
