In Year 13, you will study the following topics:

- The public reaction to immigration
- Life in the 2 German States
- Events leading up to the Reunification
- Germany since the Reunification
- German Literary Texts: Der Besuch der alten Dame(by Friedrich Dürrenmatt), the film Good Bye Lenin!

You will continue to practise listening, speaking (including preparation of an IRP), reading and writing, as well as translation into and out of German.

You will continue your weekly speaking classes with our German conversation assistant Frau Willmans.

Grammar

Grammar taught in year 12 will be taught and revisited throughout the course in each unit of work. This will include new grammar:

- Relative pronouns and clauses
- · The subjunctive in indirect speech
- The future perfect
- The subjunctive in the past
- The subjunctive 2 for wishes and polite requests

Assessment

You will be regularly tested on both vocabulary and grammar throughout the course and there will be end-of-unit assessments.

In the December mocks and A Level you will take papers that will include assessment in all four skills.
