Attendance

We know there are roadworks locally that are affecting travel. A reminder that the warning bell sounds at 8.35am, when students should be in registration. The registers are taken at 8.40am, so anyone not in form at that time is late.

Attendance at school is vitally important if students are to achieve their potential. Statistics from our own GCSE outcomes in 2023 show the following progress made by students according to their attendance:

- GCSE outcomes for students in school for at least 90% of the time were 0.7 of a grade better than the
 national average for all students
- GCSE outcomes for students in school for at least 95% of the time were 0.8 of a grade better than the national average for all students
- GCSE outcomes for students in school for 80% or less of the time were **0.6** of a grade **below** the national average for all students

We continue to work with parents to ensure high attendance from all students, and we thank you for your support with this.

U14 National Cup Football

Congratulations to our U14 football team who beat Sandringham School 6-1 in the first round of the National Schools Cup. This is the first time we have entered this competition.
