In Year 11, you will study the following **topics**:

Autumn Term: relationships with family and friends, marriage and partnerships, social media, mobile technology, music

Spring Term: cinema, TV, travel and tourism, holidays and accommodation, social and global issues, poverty, homelessness

Summer Term: revision

You will continue to practise the four skills of listening, speaking, reading (including translation from Italian into English) and writing (including translation into Italian). We will also regularly revisit the Sound Symbol Correspondences to help with pronunciation, spelling and comprehension.

Grammar will be taught and revisited throughout the course in each unit of work.

This will include:

- a range of tenses (present, perfect, imperfect, future, conditional)
- impersonal phrases
- the subjunctive
- question words
- prepositions



Assessment

At the end of each unit you will complete a topic card in preparation for the speaking/writing exams and there will be end-of-unit assessments.

In the summer exam you will take papers in speaking, reading, writing and listening.
