#### **Sixth Form Open Evening**

A reminder that we have our Sixth Form Open Evening on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> November. We look forward to welcoming our current Year 11 and external students who can find out more about our A Level offer. The event runs from 6.00pm until 8.00pm.

As part of the transition process from Year 11 to 12, we ran our Year 11 Career Futures day yesterday. There were A Level taster sessions for those students who are considering this route. During the morning, our students were given the opportunity to experience all subjects which are not offered at GCSE, for example, Media, Psychology, and Politics. In the afternoon, they chose to attend taster sessions in subjects which are offered at GCSE, for example, Physics, German, and PE.

For our Year 11s who are considering pursuing a college pathway, they visited both the Broxbourne and Ware Hertford Regional College campuses. They experienced what college life would be like and also spent time in different departments. They thoroughly enjoyed participating in sessions such as Fashion, Media Makeup and Travel & Tourism. We hope our students benefited from the day which was designed to enable them to make informed decisions regarding their choices after GCSEs.

#### A Level Trip to Germany

They were excellent ambassadors for Presdales, visiting our two partner schools in Düsseldorf and Erkrath, where they were able to meet and exchange ideas with young people of their own age.
