Listen to the <u>first movement</u> of each of these Symphonies from different eras of the symphony's development. Write your own responses, make it instinctive - you don't have to research it thoroughly, but listen carefully and respond using musical vocabulary as indicated. Symphonies usually had 4 movements (sections) to them. All of the examples below are the first movement of the symphony.
