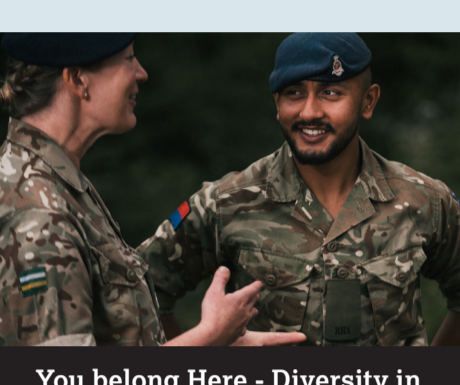

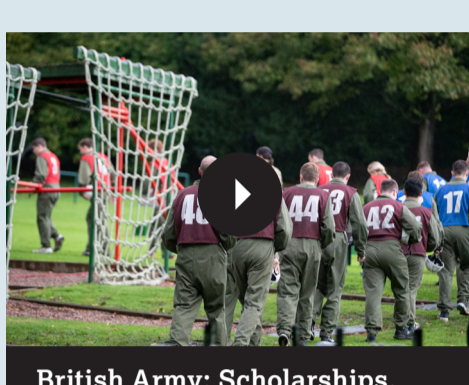

Applications to join the Army as an Intern are **CLOSING on the 31st January 2025**. The Army Internship Programme is your opportunity to experience a challenging and rewarding year with the Army in the role of an Army Officer for 12 months before, during or after University.



SCHOLARSHIP WINDOW

[NOW OPEN!](#)

Applications to join the Army Scholarship Programme are **NOW OPEN** until 31st March 2025. Get up to £10,000 in financial support through the Army Officer Scholarship Scheme, beginning in Academic Year 13. Secure a spot at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst and kickstart your career as an Army Officer post-education. Additionally, while at university, you have the opportunity to apply for other bursaries like the Enhanced or DSUS undergraduate bursaries, or even a Medical Bursary if you're pursuing nursing or medicine.



FULLY FUNDED DEGREE

LEADERSHIP/STRATEGIC STUDIES

Instead of heading off to university, you can get a fully-funded degree with the Army. Your 42 weeks' training at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst counts towards a BSc in Leadership and Strategic Studies, from the Henley Business School and the University of Reading. You can carry on with your studies alongside your career beyond the academy, and you will not have to pay any fees.

If you've already got a degree, you could apply for a place on the Army's Masters programme. This follows the same path as above but earns you a MSc in Leadership and Strategic Studies, at the start of your Army career.

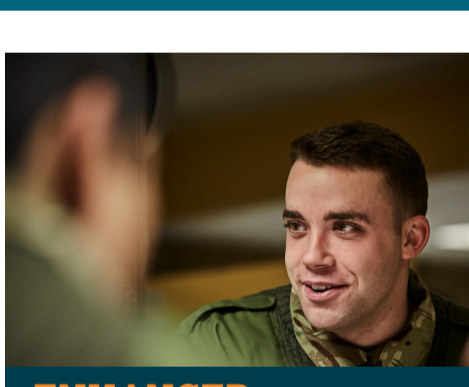
ARMY UNDERGRADUATE BURSARIES



STANDARD BURSARY - UP TO £7000

The Standard Army Undergraduate Bursary is open to undergraduates interested in joining the Army as an Officer after university. **£6,000** is typically paid to you throughout your course (**£7,000 for four-year degrees**).

ENHANCED BURSARY - UP TO £24000

The Enhanced Army Undergraduate Bursary is open to those who have achieved a minimum of ABB at A-Level, or equivalent, expect to achieve a 2:1 degree or higher and can demonstrate the qualities of a potential Officer. **A bursary of up to £24,000 is available.**

DSUS UP TO £42,750

DEFENCE STEM UNDERGRADUATE SPONSORSHIP (DSUS)

Up to **£42,750** (£5k yearly bursary + tuition fees) for students on STEM degree courses commissioning into the Royal Engineers, Royal Signals, Royal Logistic Corps, Royal Electrical and Mechanical Engineers, Royal Artillery, all branches of the Adjutant's General's Corps, Army Air Corps or Intelligence Corps.

MEDICAL BURSARIES

MEDICAL BURSARIES

ROYAL ARMY MEDICAL SERVICES BURSARIES - UP TO £75,000

Apply in your first or second year of your degree. You could receive £10,000 (£5,000 for Vet and Pharmacy students) in each of the final three years of your degrees, work your foundation years as a medical cadet, and receive a lump sum of £45,000 (or £36,000 for Pharmacists) when you complete the short course at Royal Military Academy Sandhurst.

NURSING DEGREE

NURSING STUDENTS - OFFICER ENTRY

There are two ways to fund your nursing degree: either with an Officer Nursing Bursary, or by studying nursing as a paid Soldier. You can apply for an Army Officer Nursing Bursary with an unconditional offer to study nursing (at a University of your choice) and you'll receive a £5,000 bursary per year. Upon completion of your initial military training, you will receive a lump sum of £27,000.
