Year 10 Learn4Living (L4L) Workshops

This week, Year 10 students took part in two different L4L workshops exploring the areas of Deep Fakes and Image Sharing, and Extremism. As you can appreciate some of this content is quite challenging; our Year 10 students worked well, made valuable contributions, and asked questions when needed.

Online Update

Following an investigation into Year 7 phone misuse this week, we are bringing to our parents' attention two platforms that you may not be aware of. Whilst the issue was in Year 7, it would be useful for all parents to speak to their children.

WhatsApp 'Channels'

WhatsApp has introduced a "Channels" feature that functions much like a public Instagram or TikTok feed. Students can create public channels that anyone can follow. Crucially, while posters/channel owners are easily identifiable, individuals who join/view the channel are protected by privacy settings. This means viewers/followers can potentially screenshot, share content, or react/comment (depending on settings) in a way that is hard to trace, shielding those who might be spreading content or causing harm.

'Anonymous Messages' Website

A new website, referred to by students as 'Anonymous Messages' (like the past YOLO/Tellonym platforms), is being used. This platform allows students to write completely anonymous messages to one another. As we experienced with YOLO a few years ago, this function is being used to circulate rumours/cause a lot of issues generally.

Rudolph Run - Fundraising for Isabel Hospice

Year 7 are taking part in a 'Rudolph Run' on Thursday 11th December to raise money for Isabel Hospice. The Hospice provides vital palliative care services to anyone in Eastern Hertfordshire who needs them. To be able to continue to provide their services free of charge, Isabel Hospice needs to raise £7 million every year and, although the NHS funds 30% of this, the rest relies on the community, government grants, and their retail stores.
