Many congratulations to our U16 football, who last Friday night became the Hertfordshire County Cup champions, beating a strong Sandringham team 5-4.

Report from Mr Macrae:

The result looked assured at half time with Presdales leading 4-0, however the first goal of the second half was always going to be important. That goal fell to Sandringham which gave them encouragement. A period of domination by Sandringham led them to reduce the scoreline to 4-3 with 20 minutes left.

At this stage, the momentum was definitely with Sandringham however we made a couple of tactical changes which steadied things. Presdales then scored a beautifully worked goal. Sienna R drove past her defender on the left wing and crossed a perfect ball for Miley T who was charging into the area. Miley took it first time and steered the ball clinically into the corner. A brilliant assist and a truly outstanding finish!

This gave Presdales a bit of breathing space with a 5-3 lead and around 10 minutes left (plus extra time). This last period of the game was incredibly tense. Ruby U made a couple of incredible saves but Sandringham still managed to score again to make it 5-4 with just a few minutes left. It seemed like the final whistle would never come but thankfully it did! An epic final between two fantastic teams but overall Presdales deserved the victory.



Well done to our U14 team, who made it to the District Final, which was played yesterday. Unfortunately, they came up against a very strong Freman College team, losing 8-2. The girls gave their all but faced a stronger opponent on the day. Their effort and commitment can't be faulted.
